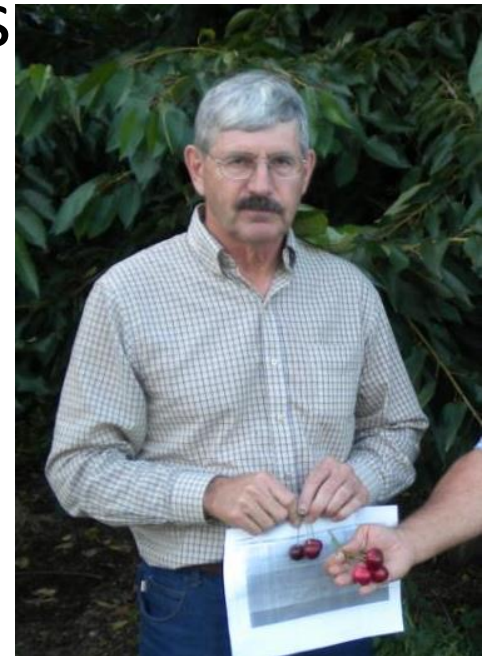

# IFG's Chilling definitions

- Low Chill < 300 hours
- Low-Mid Chill 300 – 500 hours
- Medium Chill 500 – 700 hours
- High Chill 700 + hours



# Cheery Crunch™

- Ripens 7 days before Royal Dawn in Chile
- Bloom VERY early (frost?)
- Chelan size (24 mm)
- Very low Chill
- Productive
- Very firm (400+)
- Great Flavor
- Excellent post-harvest
  - Very little bruising
- Commercial in Aus
- Not in SA yet



# Cheery Burst™

- Ripens with Royal Dawn
- Low-mid chill
- Large fruit (28 mm)
- Good firmness (300+)
- Unknown allele
- In SA: Test plots



# Cheery Grand™

- Ripens with Royal Dawn
- Blooms with Lapins
- Medium chill
- Good firmness (260-320)
- Very large (30-32 mm)
- Commercial in Chile and Aus
- Pollinizers – Santina or Lapins
- In SA: Quarantine





# Cheery Treat™

- 0-3 days < Royal Dawn
- Medium chill
- Large fruit (30 mm)
- Good firmness (280-340)
- Good crop
- Excellent eating quality
- Bing shape
- Very good post-harvest quality in USA and Chile
- Unknown allele
- In SA: Quarantine



# Cheery Moon™

- Ripens with Santina
- High chill
- Good size (29 mm)
- Firmness (290)
- Good flavor
- Excellent post harvest
- Good stem
- Commercialized in Chile
- In SA: In Test plots



# Cheery Blush™

- 14-18 days before Rainier
- Low chill
- Early blooming
- Productive
- Moderate size (26 mm)
- Very firm (350+)
- Long stems
- Commercial in Aus
- In SA: In test plots



# Cheery Glow™

- Ripens 7 to 10 days before Rainier
- Low-mid chill
- Moderate to good size (27 mm)
- Productive
- Good firmness (280-300)
- Very good sweet flavor
- Long stems
- Good post-harvest results
- In SA: Quarantine
